Many believe that entering into marriage is the final step in a romantic relationship. But marriage is not meant to be the final step in a couple's relationship - it is really just the beginning of a grand adventure, which hopefully, will be long and fruitful, enriching both husband and wife.

Marriage is a gift of God in creation through which husband and wife may know the grace of God. It is given that as man and woman grow together in love and trust, they shall be united with one another in heart, body and mind, as Christ is united with his bride, the Church.
